

Babich Winemakers' Reserve Syrah 2012

This deep coloured Syrah is produced from a special selection of grapes grown in the stony soils of our lrongate vineyard in the Gimblett Gravels region of Hawke's Bay. The peppery aroma and strong berry fruit flavours are characteristic of this variety.

Region:

Hawke's Bay - Gimblett Gravels

Recommended Food:

The sweet fruit flavours, edged by savoury oak make this wine an ideal partner to red meat dishes. Try it with pan-fried lamb cutlets, or with braised beef spooned over mashed potatoes.

Recommended Cellaring:

2-6 years

Production Notes:

These grapes were harvested after a long steady ripening through late summer/ early autumn from our Gimblett Road vineyard in Hawke's Bay. The fruit was fermented in open vats with frequent plunging of the "cap". The young wine went to new and old French oak for maturation for a period of 9 months.

Technical Notes:

Alcohol: 12.0% TA: 6.2g/l pH 3.68 Residual Sugar 0g/l

Tasting Notes:

Aromas of black plum and black pepper and spices, followed by a vibrant and refreshing palate. Soft tanins, Lovely fruit intensity and elegant structure.
