Supple and sweet-fruited with savoury complexity, balanced by a full-flavoured, soft tannin finish.





WINEMAKER NOTES

Plums, blueberry and forest berries with vanilla and violet notes, spicy leather.

Finely focused entry with dark fruits, liquorish and cinnamon. Elements of Christmas cake also detected.
Warm, fleshy and dense. Sweetly brooding on the finish.

FOOD RECOMMENDATION

A hearty wine that complements flavoursome casseroles, beef, lamb and other full-bodied dishes.
