WINEMAKER NOTES

Dark-fruited and warmly spiced, with layers of blackberry, mulberry and plum lifted by anise, nutmeg and a touch of vanilla. Subtle chocolate adds depth and warmth.

Sweet-fruited on entry, carrying dense yet finely knit tannin. Juicy black fruits and Doris plum build through the mid-palate with notes of leather and spice, giving a sense of power within an elegant frame. Long, dark and complex to close.

FOOD RECOMMENDATION

Ideal with roasted red meats. It makes a good partner for a whole fillet beef. Also perfect with a tasty winter casseroled stew.
